I am objecting to the Council's plans to build on Loes Farm as this will cause irreversible destruction to a significant portion of Warwick's green belt. The 1981 wild life charter states the need to preserve Britain's wildlife. As per the 2008 County Museum Habitat Biodiversity Assessment which identified the land at Loes Farm as being unfavourable for development in comparison with other sites on the basis of the ridge and furrow meadow habitat. This land also has 13 significant trees of which at least 3 are 100 years + old. Also there are 1700 century hedges running along the edge of the field which are covered by the Hedge Charter of 1997.

More agreeable sites could be used to build on (brown sites) such as completing the building work
