The small area identified as above is relatively small at 180 houses and would represent only a small gain in provision of local housing - A low percentage of the whole of the proposed sustained Community Strategy.  
However, the negative impact on the immediate surround will be far greater than any benefit to local plans. Loss of green space on the edge of a well established housing estate, Woodles park (which is naturally bordered by the Bypass, Coventry Road and Canal) and should be left at that, the need to remove beautiful, mature <sup>healthy</sup> trees for building and increased traffic access including re-routing Woodles Lane onto private hill. Replanting of saplings is a poor exchange for the loss of trees which have been there for a long time giving a wonderful look to the countryside. Disproportionate disruption of a unique landscape for minimal achievement is not desirable. Warwick District Council should be protecting our <sup>countryside</sup> not <sup>obscuring</sup> it. Whether this is a proposal at present or not - this area is definitely NOT suitable for a Gypsy/Traveller site being far too close to existing properties for reasons stated above.

Resolution:- Leave this area alone, look at brown shaded area\* (on map as detailed above) adjacent to Coventry Road and Canal. This land has no special value or significance and access via Montague Road would have far less negative impact on existing surround if used for new housing  
\* NOT currently numbered.
