- \* Burton Green will be spoiled by HS2 bisecting the village. Houses + the village hall will be demolished and massive disruption caused for many years. Unsuitable location therefore for 80 new homes.
- \* Many new homes within a mile of the village. (250 + 50/60 under construction + hundreds more in Banner Lane is within 2-miles of the village).
- \* Infrastructure, particularly roads inadequate - queuing through village at peak times. Much business traffic to Warwick Uni / <sup>Westwood</sup> Business Park. Further disruption of HS2 serious problem.
- \* The local plan is ill-conceived + the effects on Burton Green residents ignored.
- \* Local plan to build 830 properties in 11 villages in Warks, which will destroy the nature of these villages and need massive expenditure on infrastructure to accommodate this.
- \* All brown field sites should be fully built on before any built elsewhere.
- \* It would be better to build 10/12 properties per village in more locations tailored to individual village requirements.

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
