

My wife and I both register our objections to the proposed housing developments shown in your booklet, Local Plan, preferred options, dated may 2012.

Firstly, in locations 1-12, the proposal is to build 7020houses across the locations, shown on the map, plus a further 850 houses in 2 "villages", who's sites are not disclosed.

These are in addition to the housing to be built on the Ford site.

This means that there have to be something like 15,000 jobs made available, for the proposed occupiers.

Has this been taken into consideration, or are you expecting that the new housing will be taken by people who currently commute into the area? There may be some local employees who will move, but I suspect that the majority will continue to commute.

At a meeting I recently attended, it was reported that the Warwick Gates development would not be continuing in the near future, as some of the housing already built is still unsold.

This being the case, the argument for building on green field sites is not sustainable.

I believe I am correct in saying that the Loes Farm area is a site of special scientific interest, and as such cannot be built on. Is this correct?, and if so
