- 1 LOCAL PLAN TO BUILD 830 PROPERTIES IN 11 VILLAGES IN WARWICKSHIRE, WHICH WILL DESTROY THE VERY NATURE OF THESE VILLAGES, AND NEED MASSIVE EXPENDITURE ON INFRASTRUCTURE TO ACCOMMODATE THIS, PARTICULARLY ON ROADS, SCHOOLS AND AMENITIES.
- 2 ALL BROWN FIELD SITES HAVE TO BE FULLY BUILT ON BEFORE ANY BUILT ELSEWHERE.
- 3 BETTER ALTERNATIVE TO BUILD 1012 PROPERTIES PER VILLAGE IN MORE LOCATIONS, TAILORED TO INDIVIDUAL VILLAGE REQUIREMENTS. THESE WOULD EASILY BE INTEGRATED WITHOUT AFFECTING CHARACTER OF VILLAGE OR PUTTING FURTHER PRESSURES ON INFRASTRUCTURE. IN FACT 12 HOMES ARE BEING BUILT NOW WITHIN 1/2 MILE WITH ABSOLUTELY NO IMPACT
- 4 BURTON GREEN WILL BE DESTROYED BY HS2 BISECTING THE VILLAGE, FORCING DEMOLITION OF HOUSES AND THE VILLAGE HALL, AND CAUSE MASSIVE DISRUPTION FOR MANY YEARS. THIS IS NOT AN ATTRACTIVE OR Viable LOCATION FOR UP TO 80 NEW HOMES WITH HS2 SO NEAR.
- 5 250 NEW HOMES HAVE ALREADY BEEN BUILT WITHIN A MILE OF THE VILLAGE, WITH ANOTHER 500 UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN TILE HILL - THESE RANGE FROM 1 TO 7 BEDROOMS. HUNDRETS MORE HOMES ARE BEING BUILT 2 MILES AWAY ON SANDER LANE.
- 6 WARWICK UNIVERSITY HAS BEEN AND WILL BE EXTENDED DRAMATICALLY, WHILE WESTWOOD BUSINESS PARK HAS GROWN AND TILE HILL STATION CAR PARK HAS TREBLED IN SIZE. THIS HAS BEEN DONE WITH NO IMPROVEMENT IN ANY FORM OF INFRASTRUCTURE, PARTICULARLY THE ROADS. THIS LEADS TO QUEUES RIGHT THROUGH THE VILLAGE AND WESTWOOD HEATH BAD DURING PEAK TIMES. EXISTING ROADS WILL NOT cope.
- 7 THE IMPACT OF HS2 ON THIS AREA IS NOT UNDERSTOOD OR APPRECIATED, NOR THE NUMBER OF PROPERTIES THAT HAVE ALREADY BEEN BUILT IN COVENTRY ADJACENT TO BURTON GREEN. THIS HAS ALREADY PUT MASSIVE STRAIN ON LOCAL ROADS. THE DISRUPTION AND DESTRUCTION CAUSED BY HS2 WILL ONLY EXACERBATE THE SITUATION.
- 8 THE LOCAL PLAN IS ILL-CONCEIVED IN PRINCIPLE AND THE EFFECTS ON BURTON GREEN RESIDENTS AND VOTERS TOTALLY IGNORED. THE VILLAGE IS BEING DESTROYED.
