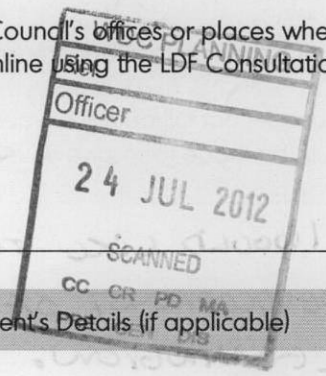

1. I WOULD LIKE TO OBJECT STRONGLY TO THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF GREENBELT LAND TO THE NORTH OF LEAMINGTON. GREENBELT OF THIS QUALITY IS RARE AND IS HEAVILY USED BY WALKERS, RAMBLERS, RUNNERS, AND CYCLISTS. THERE ARE FEW PLAY PAVES IN THE AREA AND THE CHILDREN WILL LOSE AN IMPORTANT AMENITY.
2. THE "VERY SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES" FOR BUILDING ON GREENBELT HAS NOT BEEN PROVED - THE 2009 CORE STRATEGY INDICATED NON-GREENBELT LAND IS AVAILABLE FOR DEVELOPMENT.
3. THE GREENBELT HELPS PRESERVE THE NATURE OF LEAMINGTON AS A HISTORIC TOWN - AND PREVENTS A SPRAWLING CONURBATION TO KENILWORTH. BUILDING PLAS ANORTHMAN RELIEF ROAD WOULD VERY MUCH PUT THAT AT RISK.
4. THE TRAFFIC FLOW ~~AND~~ GOING SOUTH THROUGH LEAMINGTON ACROSS THE RIVER WILL GET MUCH WORSE - AND A NORTHERN RELIEF ROAD WILL NOT SOLVE THAT.
5. NEW OUT OF TOWN SITES WILL BADLY IMPACT LEAMINGTON RETAIL ~~AND~~ APPROACH - CURRENTLY QUITE SPECIAL...


THIS ASSUMPTION IS TOO OPTIMISTIC.
