The area around old Milverton village and the River Avon should be protected.

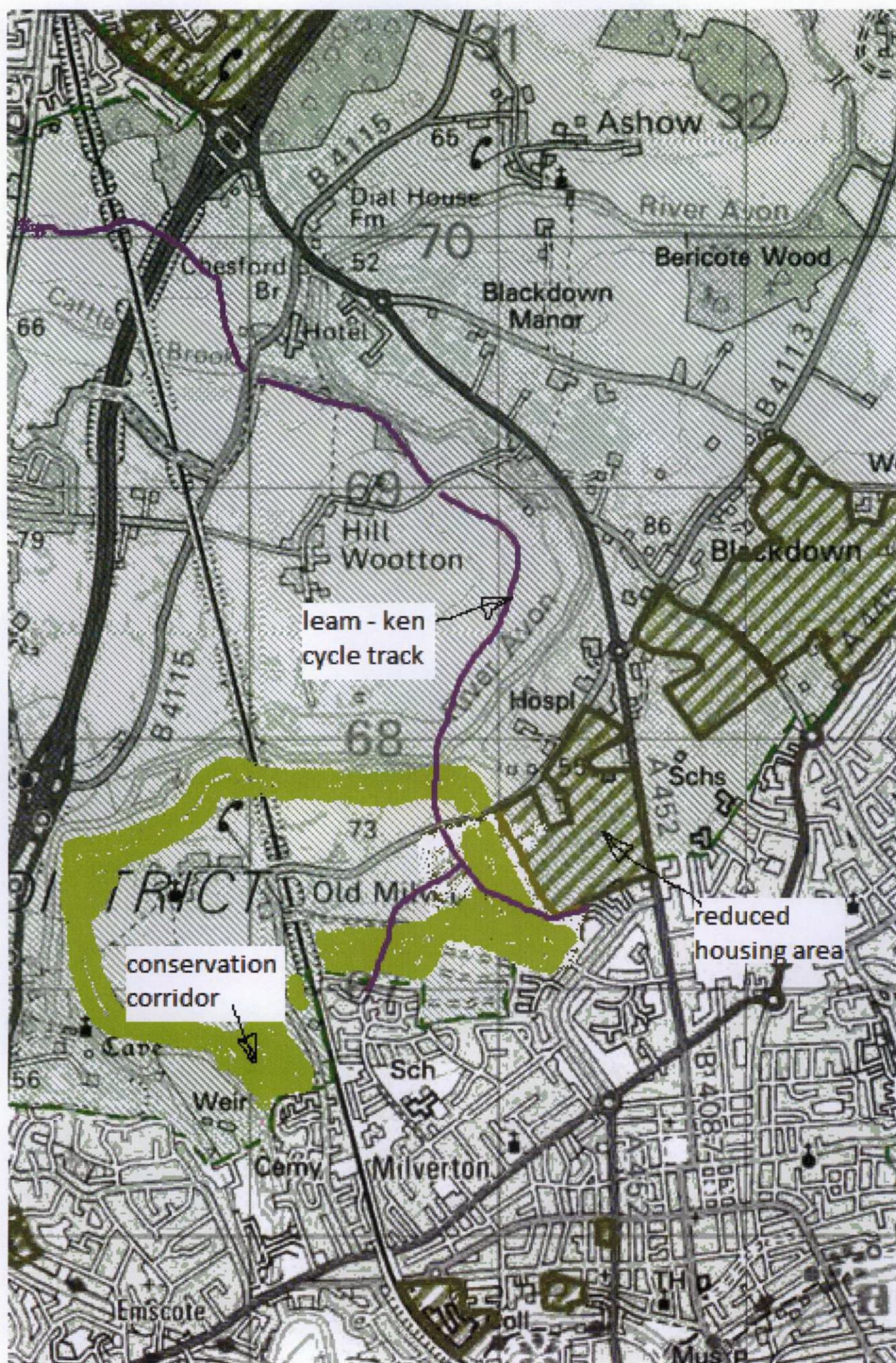
Reasons:
