We object to the allocation of the land referred to as Thickthorn Kenilworth for the following reasons:-

- The proposed allocation site serves all of the five purposes for Green Belt, as set out in paragraph 80 of the NPPF.
- The site includes established facilities for outdoor sports + recreation. Why relocate them to other Green Belt areas?
- The site includes an important area of nature conservation and is part of the wildlife corridor crossing Kenilworth. By building up to the A46 wildlife movement would be hindered.
- Noise pollution levels - already high and often very intrusive - due to the A46 - will be increased by the proposed Highway Improvements. Perhaps WDC could buck the trend of building new homes next to major arterial routeways and thus subjecting new residents to unacceptably high levels of traffic noise.
- The proposed site cannot be easily accessed so infrastructure costs will be high thus increasing the risk of inadequate service provision and poor housing quality as developers try to cut corners.
- Kenilworth needs to evolve, but future development needs to be cost effective and environmentally sound. The development of the Thickthorn site does not satisfy these criteria.

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
