Chapter 7 Village Plans and Housing Options

This representation refers to the settlement of Barford.

We act as agents and planning consultants to the Trustees of Warwick United Charities who are the owners of the land we have shown edged in red upon the attached plan.

Our clients object to the proposals set out within Chapter 7 for the following reasons:

Our clients object to the exclusion of their land as an identified future development site as there would appear to be no logic in including site 2 but excluding other land between the existing settlement boundary and the bypass.

Our clients are also aware that planning consent has recently been issued for other development on Westham Lane and as a consequence the entire area north and south of Westham Lane between the existing development and the bypass should be identified for future development.
