This representation is made on behalf of Warwickshire Police and West Mercia Police (the Alliance), in respect of their landholdings, the Former Warwickshire Police HQ site. The site lies on the western edge of Leek Wootton, which is identified as a Growth Village – that is, one of the District’s most sustainable rural settlements – within the Publication Draft Local Plan. It is allocated for housing through Policy DS11.

This representation supports the proposed modifications to Paragraphs 2.41 to 2.51, as shown in Appendix B of the schedule of modifications, in particular in respect of paragraph 2.42, which provides an Explanation for Policy DS11, and paragraph 2.56 on Village Allocations.

**Paragraph 2.42**

The proposed modifications to Policy DS11, include a wider, and single, allocation of the Former Warwickshire Police HQ site for an estimated 115 dwellings (Ref: DSNEW3). The Alliance supports the recognition that the housing figures for each site in Policy DS11 are estimates, and that in most cases will represent the minimum site capacity.



In this respect, the Alliance is pursuing a masterplanning approach, in accordance with proposed modification Policy DS NEW3, which is underpinned by an extensive technical evidence base. To date this work indicates that the site has potential to accommodate in the region of 125 new homes, and as such, demonstrates that the level of housing proposed within Policy DS11 is deliverable. The Masterplan and its supporting evidence base will be made available in due course to support the proposed modification at the resumed examination stage.

In addition, further work is underway in respect of more detailed consideration of the capacity of the site, including the conversion potential of the Grade II listed Woodcote House, together with a viability appraisal to inform an appropriate balance between the scale of development and obligations and policy burdens, in line with paragraph 173 of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). This will need to take account of the specific circumstances of the site, including that significant demolition and restoration work will be required to enhance the site's historic value. The findings of these assessments will also be made available in due course, in order to support the proposed modification at the resumed examination stage.

The Alliance is aware that the Parish Council has concerns over the level of housing being proposed for the Former Warwickshire Police HQ site. However, through constructive dialogue, supported by the findings of the capacity and viability assessments, the Alliance will seek to reach agreement with the Parish Council and the District Council as to the broad capacity of the site prior to the commencement of the resumed examination hearings.

***Paragraph 2.56***

The Alliance support the proposed deletion of wording in the Publication Draft Local Plan, which prescribed that sites of over 50 dwellings should be delivered in phases. This would delay the delivery of housing and, in the case of the Former Warwickshire Police HQ site, would risk constraining the ability to plan for, and develop, the site as a comprehensive whole, as required by proposed modification Policy DS NEW3. There is also a risk that any early phase would focus on the greenfield parts of the site, thereby delaying delivery of the significant brownfield element, including conversion of the Grade II listed Woodcote House, contrary to core principles of the NPPF which encourage the reuse of brownfield land and conservation of heritage assets (paragraph 17).

It is noted that the deletion to paragraph 2.56 includes a cross reference Policy H10 (Bringing Forward Allocated Sites in the Growth Villages) and consideration will need to be given to the wording of this policy and its supporting text in order to ensure consistency between different parts of the plan.
