- Reaction from WDC appears to be put all of Coventry's overspill on the Coventry border but the build will remain under Warwickshire jurisdiction. The housing numbers could be dispersed into smaller localised groups of houses, giving a greater chance of community cohesion.
- The original Local Plan did not mention Kings Hill. this appeared as an amendment in February 2016.
- The extra housing was added to satisfy initial report from Inspector on cross border co-operation. There was no recommendation that WDC should take the large percentage of Coventry's unmet housing numbers.

 - This application is expecting to producing 4000 new dwellings on Kings Hill because CCC claims not to have the land on which to build them.. WDC has decided to put all 4000l on H43..
 - Apart from the problem of getting 4000 units on this site, there is a problem achieving social harmony within this 'New Town'. . Ideally, there should be no more than 24 new units in an established area.. Finham cannot support 4000 new dwellings.
 - Given the set concept, there would need to be a Green Belt area separating CCC's boundary from this development. Detailed plans should be publicised to optimise any outcome.
