It is submitted that the Preferred Option under Paragraph 8.14 and clarified at 8.30 as to its meaning is out of date and at vaniance with the underlying objectives of the Framework which supports economic growth and the provision of jobs. Jobs are not just sourced from development within Class B of the Town and Country Planning Use Classes Order 1987. There are a wide varge of uses which provide economic development and hence jobs which may be suitable on land that is allocated for employment development. Restricting the use of employment land to class B uses will present an unrecessary barrier to economic investment and job creation. Such an approach is at variance with the strategy promoted by the Coventry and Warnickshire LEP which recognises that jobs are provided by a wide range of developments, and that it is vital that local plans are up to date with present day economic circumstances.
